The propulsion system is arguably the most critical part of the aircraft; it certainly is the single most expensive component of the vehicle. Ensuring that engines operate reliably without major maintenance issues is an important goal for all operators, military or commercial. Engine health management (EHM) is a critical piece of this puzzle and has been a part of the engine maintenance for more than five decades. Metal bonding has been included partly because the definition of "composite" can be interpreted to include metal-skinned honeycomb panels, and partly because some composite parts have metal fittings or reinforcements that must be treated before bonding. This third edition also covers a number of the problems experienced in service, some of which may be applicable to metallic sandwich panels, offers suggestions for design improvements, including repair design as a particular topic, and regulatory changes. *Care and Repair of Advanced Composites, 3rd Edition*, provides solid technical information and training for a wide range of airline staff.
