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Although it is the first section of your paper, the abstract should be written last

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In order to write one, you have to know what abstracts are exactly. Well, an abstract is defined as a concise summary of a larger project; it describes the content and scope of the project while identifying objective, methodology, findings, and conclusion.

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An informational abstract is like a mini-paper. Its length ranges from a paragraph to 1-2 pages, depending on the scope of the report. Aim for less than 10% the length of the full report. Summarize all aspects of the report, including purpose, method, results, conclusions, and recommendations.

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
