Teaching and learning introductory physics are both challenging tasks. While traditional methods have led to frequently disappointing results, I have tried to show that there is hope. As instructors, we should heed the lessons about our students' thought processes learned from research into "common sense" ideas about physics and into students' difficulty with formal mathematical reasoning.
