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Experimental research is basically any study that is steered with a scientific methodology in mind, whereas multiple variables remain constant while the others are measured (Gravetter & Forzano, 2015). Experimental research gathers a lot of data which helps the decision making process and is the main institution of quantitative research methods.

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In order to do this, psychologists utilize the scientific method to conduct psychological research. The scientific method is a set of principles and procedures that are used by researchers to develop questions, collect data, and reach conclusions.
