This book was undertaken to provide a text and reference on the theory and practice of the FFT and its common usage. This book is organized in only four chapters, and is intended as a tutorial on the use of the FFT and its trade space. The trade space of the FFT is the parameters in its usage and the rela-

tionships between them - the sample rate, the total number of points or the interval over which processing occurs in a single FFT, the selectivity of tuning to a given frequency over signals out-of-band, and the bandwidth over which a signal appears.
