Pediatric palliative care and pediatric hospice care (PPC-PHC) are often essential aspects of medical care for patients who have life-threatening conditions or need end-of-life care. PPC-PHC aims to relieve suffering, improve quality of life, facilitate informed decision-making, and assist in care coordination between clinicians and across sites of care.

Pediatric Palliative Care and Hospice Care Commitments ...

Like palliative care, hospice provides comprehensive comfort care as well as support for the family, but, in hospice, attempts to cure the person's illness are stopped. Hospice is provided for a person with a terminal illness whose doctor believes he or she has 6 months or less to live if the illness runs its natural course.

Pediatric palliative care differs significantly from palliative care for adults in myriad ways, especially as end of life approaches. These courses - which can be taken individually or as full Certificate programs - are designed to help clinicians gain confidence and expertise in caring for young patients with serious or terminal illness.

Certificates in Pediatric Palliative Care

Pediatric palliative or hospice care may begin once a referral (formal request) is provided. The patient will generally receive their first visit within a 48 hour period after the formal request has been approved by a physician.
