#### Ask a classmate to read through what you have written ...

Peer edited research papers are slightly different from most academic papers written for courses. Papers that will undergo peer review are special papers that not only argue a case, but also expand the body of knowledge in an academic field. Those peer editing research papers will immediately look for a thesis statement.

Ask a classmate to read through what you have written, check off the box next to each question, and write a brief comment that will help improve your work. Also important for your research paper editing checklist is in-line citations. After all, this is a research paper, meaning you had to research other people's work. If you use their ideas but don't give them credit in the body of the paper, you are plagiarizing! The penalty for this at most universities is a failing grade.
