It is acknowledged to be the most persuasive brief popular statement of the Lone Nut theory. As an author, Dr. Steele is admired for his iconoclastic study of George Orwell's thinking, *Orwell Your Orwell: A Worldview on the Slab* (2017), praised by Yuri Maltsev as "absolutely dazzling"; his popular exposition of atheism, *Atheism Explained: From Folly to Philosophy* (2008), not only admired by atheists but also frequently praised by believers for its fair-mindedness; and his demonstration of the practical impossibility of Marxian socialism, *From Marx to Mises* (1992).
