Postgraduate year two (PGY-2) emphasizes a specific area of interest and helps lead to specialization in that field.

Post Graduate Year 1 (PGY1) The first year consists of six months of general medical training and six months of psychiatry. Residents are expected to practice as a pharmacist in designated areas for 4 shifts every 4 week scheduling period (one weekend and two evenings) starting August 1 and extending throughout the residency year. The total number of scheduled shifts during the year will approximate 48.
