Why is Real Estate Funds risk management important? Given the influence of real estate on Luxembourg's alternative investment fund industry (more than 300 funds with total net assets under management just below €40 billion), RICS Luxembourg has produced a paper to provide guidance to the industry on real estate risk management.
