In the running record in the video, the "reader" made 5 errors (we don't count the ones he self-corrected). There were 74 total words (TW), so he read 69 of them correctly (WC). $69 / 74 \times 100 = 93$. The child read this book with 93% accuracy.

Scoring After collecting information on a running record, you need to calculate the error, accuracy, and self-correction rates. The sections below provide detailed information on the formulas you will use.

Scoring The information gathered while doing a running record is used to determine error, accuracy, and self-correction rates. Directions for calculating these rates are given below. The calculated rates, along with qualitative information and the student's comprehension of the text, are used to determine the student's reading level.

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Mark the text on the running record form as the student reads from the Benchmark Passage or Benchmark Book. Before taking your first running record, become familiar with the symbols used to mark a running record form. These symbols are found in Table 1. Also review the Sample Running Record to see how a completed form looks.
