Hesse dedicated the first part of it to Romain Rolland and the second to Wilhelm Gundert, his cousin. The word Siddhartha is made up of two words in the Sanskrit language, *siddha* (achieved) + *artha* (what was searched for), which together means "he who has found meaning (of existence)" or "he who has attained his goals". In fact, the Buddha's own name, before his renunciation, was Siddhartha Gautama, Prince of Kapilvastu. In this book, the Buddha is referred to as "Gotama".

Questo libro è rivolto a chiunque desideri essere in grado di creare, trattare o modificare file in formato ePub. Non è necessaria alcuna conoscenza preventiva di ePub e la difficoltà non è differente dalla capacità di imparare altri linguaggi di marcatura o programmazione. Per gli argomenti trattati nel dettaglio in questo testo si può esaminare l'indice nell'anteprema e tutti i file di esempio nel libro potranno essere estratti da un file scaricabile dal sito dell'autore. Si sottolinea che è

possibile leggere questo libro seguendo un percorso sequenziale, dall'inizio alla fine, o si possono consultare solo i capitoli che interessano. Gli esempi in ogni capitolo non si basano necessariamente sul materiale creato in altri capitoli. Infine, dato che molti capitoli contengono note, suggerimenti e avvertenze, è opportuno tenere presenti queste sezioni durante la lettura. Una ampia seconda parte è dedicata ad argomenti avanzati e agli aspetti di accessibilità dei contenuti.

Arsène Lupin, with his characteristic wit, plots over the course of nine short stories to steal many of France's best antiques and artworks from under their owners' noses. Only his classic opponent Detective Ganimard has the brilliance to attempt to foil Arsène's plans, albeit with mixed results. This first collection of nine Arsène Lupin stories were originally serialised in the magazine *Je Sais Tout* from 1905 and translated into English in 1910. The final story of the set features Herlock Sholmes. In the original printings, Sholmes was simply an unauthorized Sherlock Holmes, but this appearance annoyed Arthur Conan Doyle; the character's name was changed to "Herlock Sholmes" for later printings and future stories. Arsène Lupin later went on to feature in over fifty stories by Maurice Leblanc along with many other books, films and plays around the world. This book is part of the Standard Ebooks project, which produces free public domain ebooks.

Virginia Woolf dreamed of the Day of Judgment. The "great conquerors and lawyers and statesmen" come to receive their rewards - crowns, laurels, names carved on marble. But, when he sees people coming with books under their arms, God turns to Peter and says: "Look, those need no reward. We have nothing to give them here. "They have loved reading." And this is the

"To read a novel is a difficult and complex art," says Virginia Woolf. Adeline Virginia Woolf (1882-1941) made an impact during her life, but her fame grew in the decades after her death. The English writer helped launch the use of stream-of-consciousness in literature and was a pioneer of 20th century modernism. Arguab-

ly her greatest legacy, though, comes from how her writing helped to inspire the feminist movements of the second half of the 20th century. Along with members of her family and other authors, Woolf helped found the Bloomsbury Group. After she married the political theorist and author Leonard Woolf in 1912, they went on to found the Hogarth Press. Virginia also had a long relationship with the writer Vita Sackville-West. The affair featured in the 2018 movie 'Vita and Virginia', starring Gemma Arterton and Elizabeth Debicki. Her best-known works include the novels 'Mrs Dalloway', 'To the Lighthouse' and 'Orlando'.
