Urine is also a water/salt solution. 20 + 20 g/L urea + 10 g/L NaCl +...The yellow colour is due to the presence of urochrome, a pigment derived from the breakdown of haemoglobin. Its density is in the range $\rho = 1005..1035$ kg/m³, according to salt concentration. The average pH of urine is 6 but ranges from 4.6 to 8.0.

Solution. a. The equality 454 g = 1 lb can be used to write two unity factors, $\frac{\text{454 g}}{\text{1 lb}}$ or $\frac{\text{1 lb}}{\text{454}}$ The given density can be multiplied by one of the unity factors to get the desired result. The correct conversion factor is chosen so that the units cancel:

Strictly speaking of Brix, only the pure sucrose content in a solution is meant. But often as well, the High Fructose Corn Syrup (HFCS) is measured and expressed in Brix °.
