Objectives: The patient-rated wrist evaluation (PRWE) and the Disabilities of the Arm, Shoulder and Hand (DASH) questionnaire are patient-reported outcome measures (PROMs) used for clinical and research purposes. Methodological high-quality clinimetric studies that determine the measurement properties of these PROMs when used in patients with a distal radial fracture are lacking.

A hand and wrist examination done in a structured manner will help to facilitate the most appropriate working diagnosis for treatment. Diagnosing hand and wrist conditions is often difficult and for this reason, bilateral comparison can be useful. Subjective History. Thorough history taking is an important first step in treating the patient.

The Patient Rated Wrist Evaluation (PRWE) is a region-specific outcome measure that evaluates wrist-related disability. It contains 15 items: five of which evaluate pain (intensity and frequency) and 10 evaluate function (specific activities and usual activities).

What is the Patient-Rated Wrist Evaluation (PRWE)? The PRWE is a 15-item questionnaire designed to measure wrist pain and disability in activities of daily living. The PRWE allows patients to rate their levels of wrist pain and disability from 0 to 10, and consists of 2 subscales: 1) PAIN subscale (0 = no pain, 10 = worst ever) ¾ Pain - 5 items

The Patient-rated Wrist Evaluation (PRWE) was developed to assess pain in the wrist joint and functional difficulties in activities of daily living resulting from injuries affecting wrist joint area (MacDermid, Turgeon, Richards, Beadle, & Roth, 1998).
