Families need to understand where they fall on the FPL so they know whether they are eligible for Medicaid in their state or whether they are eligible for a federal Subsidy because they earn between 100 and 400 percent of the FPL, or whether they are eligible for a tax credit because they ...

Revised Poverty Guidelines were issued on February 1, 2019, by the Department of Health and Human Services. Effective April 2, 2019, the revised Poverty Guidelines must be used in making determinations of eligibility for uncompensated services. These guidelines replace the Poverty Guidelines published on January 18, 2018.

Have you ever worked with data about the federal poverty level and wondered what that level was? There are two different U.S. poverty measures, both often referred to as “poverty level”—one based on poverty thresholds and one based on poverty guidelines.

The 2019 Poverty Guidelines, commonly referred to as the Federal Poverty Level or FPL, follow in the tables below. Note that these amounts change based on the number of individuals in the household and the state in which one resides.

The 2019 federal poverty level (FPL) income numbers below are used to calculate eligibility for Medicaid and the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). 2018 numbers are slightly lower, and are used to calculate savings on Marketplace insurance plans for 2019. \$12,490 for individuals; \$16,910 for a family of 2; \$21,330 for a family of 3

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
